





DUDHSAGAR WATERFALL

Dudhsagar Falls is a four-tiered waterfall located on the Mandovi River. Dudhsagar Falls is amongst India's tallest waterfalls with a height of 310 m (1017 feet) and an average width of 30 metres (100 feet). The area is surrounded by deciduous forests with rich biodiversity. This waterfall is also known as Tambdi Surla to some of the local people. The falls are not particularly spectacular during the dry season but during the monsoon season the falls are fed by rains and form a huge force of water.



Amongst the most popular beaches in Goa, Anjuna Beach has a rich past of hippie culture. However, this beach that stretches almost 2 km is also popular amongst families and water sports lovers. At night, Anjuna Beach becomes one of the best hubs in Goa for nightlife
